The chair called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. There were no public comments.

The Paddlecraft lottery will be an online process and will roll out at the end of Januaury 2025. At Corn Hill there will be beach storage in the usual spot that will be roped off and monitored. It will accommodate 10 large non powered boats (ie Hobie cats) and 18 kayaks for those with disabilities. It is hoped that once there is a new expanded recreational area, there will be space for 3 lower racks that would be handicap accessible.

Stop the Bleed training will be conducted by the Fire Department in the spring at the library.

Corn Hill is targeted for repavement in 2026. It is hoped that if the CPC joint proposal is awarded the parking lot and the boardwalk replacement will happen at the same time. There will be an easy and barrier free entrance from the parking lot to the boardwalk - a flat grade.

There was public comment at a Select Board meeting requesting the town to investigated ownership of Snow's landing as a public boat launch. The speaker indicated it had aways been used as a public assess point.

Discussion followed about the Farmer's Market Park that already has a path cut through the tall marsh grass where kayaks have launched into the pamet. Launchers usually park at the lot across from the Cobb library. There was some interest in developing a launching site to the other side of route 6 to the Pamet. There was also discussion of access to ponds.

Mary Ellen Kimball is going to investigate orgainizing a spring beach clean up.

The committee did not approve the November 14, 2024 minutes. It was requested that the secretary incorporate the fall beach reports. Minutes were tabled.

The next meeting is March 27, 2025 at 4:00 pm Damion will organize a virtual meeting.

The next in person meeting is May 1, 2025 at 4:00 pm. The invitation to the Commission of Disabilities will be made to meet jointly
