- Call to order at 3:36pm
- FOTL Update
 - Accountant is nearly finished with fixing financials
- Library Director Report-Chris Kaufmann
 - o Chris did full re-accounting for financial report
 - Uptick in E-Circulation last month
 - Weeding of books, finding locations to donate them
 - Truro Playwrights' Collective event cancelled for 1/18
 - Someone reached out about potentially including Truro in their estate planning with the goal of keeping the Truro Library at the heart of the community
 - o New downstairs door is on the DPW's fiscal year 2026 plan
 - Maggie and Chris started a Life Skills program with Cape Abilities
 - Chris will be out from Feb 1-16 for her qualifying exams

Budget Update

- Tuesday, January 21, the library will present first at 8:30am
- After meeting with Alex Lessin and Trudi Brazil, more information was needed, which Chris brought to town hall today
- There will be continued conversation with the selectboard about adding hours for one employee, possibly up until town meeting
- Concern of short staffing, especially in summer and with several employees having over two months of PTO built up
- Darrin Tangeman: Importance of changes in staffing being budget neutral and the justification for the changes
- o Robert Weinstein: It's important to highlight the importance of provision of service and the need for specialized staff to support that
- Expanding the hours: We are currently open 38 hours a week. If we open for 2 more hours per week, we can decrease materials expenditure from 19.5% of total municipal appropriation to 16%
 - For materials expenditure requirement, we have to have the hours increase for 39 weeks
- Municipal appropriation goes up every year because staff costs increase. TPL is not lowering materials budget, just decreasing the percentage they spend on materials



Website Update

- Timing will be around July for transition to CivicPlus
- o Chris has been working on tightening up current website
- o Chris is working closely with Katie Riconda to discuss digital ADA compliance

• Fax Fee Update from Darrin Tangeman

- Town counsel says Truro Library Trustees set, raise, or remove Fax Fees. Vote would have to be communicated to Alex Lessin.
- Approval of minutes Nola Glatzel
 - o Martha moved, Keith seconded, minutes approved unanimously
