PUBLIC COMMENT. None

LOWER CAPE EMEGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE: Betty and Carl met with the Select board and requested \$50,0000 from the Truro Affordable Housing Trust (AHT) for emergency rental relief to assist Truro renters in need as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Homeless Prevention Council (HPC) will administer applications and distribute funds directly to qualifying landlords. The HPC will provide monthly reports to the THA. The Select-board enthusiastically endorsed this program and offered full support unanimously voting to provide the requested funds.

DISCUSSION RE: A PUBLIC INFORMATION CAMPAIGN. The subcommittee of the THA made up of Carl Brotman, Betty Gallo and Leedara Zola presented strategies to forward outreach, education and public information regarding community housing. Included were signage on Rt. 6 and around town, pamphlets and flyers, reporting in The Banner and Independent and notices at the food bank, transfer station. Anne Greenbaum commented on the misconception around town of the role of the Affordable Housing Trust is, and that efforts to clarify that

would be beneficial. The subcommittee will continue to report to the THA regularly at future meetings.

CLOVERLEAF UPDATE. The ZBA hearing on the Cloverleaf 40B application is ongoing. A final decision is expected soon.

WALSH PROPERTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE. The committee has not met.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY 181 Rt. 6. Kevin met with Beth Wade from Habitat for Humanity at the site. Beth reiterated Habitats willingness to work with abutters to develop a satisfactory development plan for the property.
