Building Science Corporation: (BSC)

- DPW director Cabral wants to get a consultant for the upcoming renovations to Town Hall, Community Center and Library (3 to 5 years out)
- Vice-Chair Higgins-Steele gives background on Building Science Corporation. Member Irwin has worked on several projects with BSC and recommends them highly
- Member Wilson: they are innovative and good at what they do. She suggests that we adhere to best
 practices and find 3 comparable companies to suggest to SB and the DPW director. The DPW director is
 going to go vet multiple companies for CIP consultants for the 3 buildings
- EC has Tentative meeting with SB February 27
- Member Wilson: 3 paths to choose from:
 - 1) an engineering firm with good energy efficiency credentials leading the initiative
 - 2) 2 separate entities working together, an engineering firm and an energy consultant
 - 3) EC does our decarbonization planning ahead of the CIP

Higgins-Steele and Wilson state they prefer that Weston & Sampson is not the lead or sole entity to do this work.

In any event, EC needs to be ahead of the process, perhaps a memo to SB.
