Notes of the Meeting on June 20th, 2013, 4:30 PM

Location: Selectmen's meeting room, Truro Town Hall

Present: Kevin Kuechler (Chair), Mark Peters, Amanda Reed, Bill Worthington. Shannon Corea and Peter Romanelli, were absent

Also present: Pat Pajaron, Conservation and Health Agent; Charleen Greenhalgh, Assistant Town Administrator/Planner, Blake Martin of Weston & Sampson .

Kuechler reported that funds of \$2,950 are to be encumbered at the end of the Fiscal Year in case a bill from Hevener is received. The Committee signed a letter to this effect, on a motion by Reed, seconded by Peters.

On July 16<sup>th</sup> the WROC will meet at 5:15 PM to discuss the move from Phase I of the Integrated Water Resources Management Plan (IWRMP) to Phase II. This will be followed by a meeting with the Board of Selectmen.

Kuechler and Martin presented their Power-Point report which was to be provided to the Citizens' open meeting at 6:00.

On July 6<sup>th</sup> Kuechler will present a brief overview of the WROC work and the IWRMP to the Truro Non-Resident Taxpayers Association

Pajaron reported that some of the data entry for the Nitrate Sampling program may be done by Truro elder citizens, through the COA.

Minutes of the meeting of May 23<sup>rd</sup> will be reviewed at the July 16 meeting.

The Board of Selectmen was reported to have selected Bob Weinstein as their Liaison to the WROC.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 and was followed by the open meeting to review the IWRMP for Truro citizens.
